



The parents program is the involvement of parents in the Catechetical Preparation of their teenager and is an integral part of the Confirmation Process. This reparation process is intended to challenge the candidates to examine their faith life and at the same time it calls parents to conversion and to new growth in faith.

During the course of the year, parents are expected to participate in meetings through countering to bring food, donating their time and talent.

Role of the Sponsor

The sponsor should be someone who knows the candidate, helps the candidate, and witnesses to the candidate's morals, faith, and intention. (The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, #42) In the early Church, most new members were adult converts. Each candidate had a sponsor who was a guide, a spiritual companion and a witness to the faith of that candidate before the community.

In the Confirmation Preparation Process, the sponsor has a significant role in the faith development of the candidate. They are called to be:

- A model of how a person of faith lives in today's world.
- A friend who knows the candidate and can witness to the maturing faith of the candidate before the community.
- A guide, a confidant, and a listener.
- A leader who is interested in their own growth as they walk the faith joinery with the candidate.
- A companion who will continue after confirmation to walk the faith journey with the candidate and invite them into a fuller participation in parish life and service.
- A practicing and confirmed Catholic


Expectations of the Sponsor

Sponsorship in the Confirmation Process is a two-year commitment. Sponsors are invited to:

- Attend meetings, workshops or training sessions for sponsors.
- Participate in liturgical rites of the Confirmation process.
- Meet monthly with the candidate, outside of class time, to encourage and assist the candidate
 to grow in knowledge, in prayer, in service, in worship, and in participation in the parish
 Community.
- Participate in the activities of the two-year Confirmation Process with the candidate.

Qualifications of the Sponsor

- The sponsor should be at least 18 years of age, a mature person of faith, and a confirmed Catholic in good standing.
- The sponsor reflects Catholic Christian values in word, worship, and service.
- The sponsor may be male or female, may be a Baptismal Sponsor, but may NOT be a parent of the candidate.
- A sponsor participates in activities of the two-year Confirmation Process with the candidate.
- A sponsor meets personally with his/her candidate on a regular basis to discuss candidate's prayer life, to share faith, and to answer questions.
- The sponsor is friendly, trustworthy, and a good listener.
- It is helpful and advisable that sponsors are active members of the Parish.



Sponsor Checklist

- When appropriate or recommended, attend meetings with your candidate.
- Greet your candidate when he/she arrives for the meeting. Make sure they feel welcome. Your hospitality is vital. You are choosing to be this candidate's spiritual parent.
- Keep in touch outside of required meetings. Their faith journey is ongoing and your involvement, especially outside of any requirements, will show them they are important and worthy of your time.
- Invite your candidate to Mass or another service of prayer. Explain what its meaning is to you. Remember example is powerful.
- If you sense that a candidate had a difficult time understanding what was said or experienced at a group session, do not hesitate to ask if you can help. Don't push, but do offer. If you don'; t know how to respond or are not sure what the church teaches don't make it up. They will remember your answers. Make sure you are finding the information together. This will help them learn how to find answers as they continue to grow in your faith
- You can also be sensitive to other personal concerns of your candidate. If you journey with him/her for two years, there will sometimes be the need to listen to whatever is troubling your candidates, but in particular for your candidate. Take the initiative in responding to needs.
- Pray daily for all the candidates, but in particular for your candidate.
- A nice idea, if you feel comfortable, is to invite the candidate and his/her family for dinner.
- Arrange to visit one of the social agencies in the diocese or special ministry areas to witness the Church at work. Try to plan your visit with a candidate in such a way that you cans counter a few hours of your days' time assisting in the work. Some of these sites might include a nursing home, orphanage, and school for exceptional children, soup line, one of the agencies or center of Catholic Charities, or a prison. Be sure to spend some time after your visit discussing your experience. (Check your local agencies).
- Invite the candidate to parish functions other than the Sunday Liturgy. Some parishes sponsor Eucharistic preparation program, plays, renewal missions, and even bingo.
- Take time to explain the holy days and feasts of our tradition, this is a wonderful opportunity to witness to your faith. Explain the Church's fast and abstinence laws as well as the communion fast. This may sound elementary, but candidate may need a refresher in the basics.

Service Opportunities at St. Jerome

Service is an integral component of the Confirmation preparation process. Through the process, candidates are introduced to the role of service in the life and faith of the community and are offered a variety of opportunities to participate in service pro=jects. After participating in these service projects, the candidates are guided in reflecting on these experiences. Here at St. Jerome, we have a team of adults and teens who will be working to plan and facilitate service projects throughout the year. We will inform the candidates of these opportunities on a monthly basis. Each candidate is required to participate in 20 service hours each year (a total of 40 hours), muring the course of the Confirmation process. *It is the responsibility of each candidate to record their own service hours.* Prior two the Rite of Confirmation, we will request each candidate to describe the service projects they were involved in, and write a short reflection on how their participation impacted their faith. (*Use a separate sheet if necessary*).

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We, at Saint Jerome Confirmation Program, care about the safety and well-being of the children that you have entrusted into our care. An important part of our commitment is to be in compliance with the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' (USCCB) "Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People" which requires that each diocese must establish and maintain a Safe Environment Program for children and youth.

The Archdiocese of Los Angeles has adopted the *Virtus*® *Teaching Touching Safety Program for Children* as the safety program that teaches children and young people the "five basic safety rules" to help keep them safe from child sexual abuse. This also addresses topics such as boundaries, bullying, and computer and Internet safety.

We are please to offer this program to the children in the Confirmation Program at Saint Jerome. The topic for the Teaching Touching Safety Program changes yearly on a three year cycle. There will be a special meeting for parents and guardians to review this year's topic as well as to receive important resources. You are encouraged to attend so that you will have the tools you need to reinforce your child's learning experience. This meeting's date and time will be announced when finalized.
